Everyone who operates a motor vehicle, vessel, or aircraft or any railway equipment in Canada while disqualified from doing so

- (a) is guilty of an indictable offence and liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding five years; or
- (b) is guilty of an offence punishable on summary conviction.
