AFFIDAVIT OF SERVICE

- 1. A party who causes a document to be personally served must file an affidavit of service that establishes service in compliance with the Civil Procedure Rules.
- **2.** The affidavit of service must contain all of the following:
 - (a) the name of the person swearing or affirming the affidavit and of the community where they reside;
 - (b) a statement that the person personally delivered a certified copy of the notice to the person to be notified;
 - (c) a reference to an exhibited certified copy of the notice;
 - (d) the hour, date, and place of delivery;
 - (e) the name of the person to whom delivery was made;
 - (f) how the person swearing or affirming the affidavit knew the name of the person to whom delivery was made.
- **3.** The affidavit may be in Form 31.05.
- **4.** The affidavit of service must be sworn before a Commission of Oaths or a Notary Public for the Province of Nova Scotia. This can be done at the Prothonotary's Office (a fee of \$21.01 (\$18.27 plus HST) applies unless the affidavit is for filing in a Supreme Court or Court of Appeal file). A picture, signed identification such as a valid driver's licence of the person making the affidavit of service will be required.
