CAC 472252 and CAC 479782 Christopher Vincent Garnier v. Her Majesty the Queen

The Appellant in this matter is appealing his conviction and sentence for second-degree murder in the 2015 death of Catherine Campbell. A jury convicted Mr. Garnier on Dec. 21, 2017. On Aug. 13, 2018, Justice Joshua Arnold ruled on the issue of sentencing and parole ineligibility. His full written decision is available [here](#).

The appeal hearing is scheduled for a half-day beginning at 10 a.m. AST on Dec. 3 in Courtroom 502 at the Law Courts, 1815 Upper Water St., Halifax.
