

MEDIA ADVISORY: CHANGES TO THE COURTS' RECENT DECISIONS PAGE

Thursday, July 25, 2019 (Halifax, NS) – Changes are coming to the Recent Decisions page on the Nova Scotia Courts' website that will make it easier to find and access published court decisions.

The updated page will be similar in layout to other decisions web pages, including those on the Supreme Court of Canada and Federal Court websites. The daily decisions email will also be changing to a format similar to subscription services for those Courts.

Journalists who are currently receiving the daily decisions email will be automatically signed up for the new service. Those who want to opt out of this service should email decision@courts.ns.ca.

For those not currently receiving the daily decisions email, you can sign up for our mailing list using the link at the bottom of the <u>Searchable Decisions Database page</u>.

The new Recent Decisions page and mailing list sign-up are now active. The old Recent Decisions page will be maintained until July 31, as the Courts transition to the new system. As of Aug. 1, the old page will be removed, and any existing bookmarks will no longer work. Those who have bookmarked the old page are encouraged to update their bookmarks to the new page: https://decisia.lexum.com/nsc/en/nav.do.
