



MEDIA ADVISORY: ROBING CEREMONY FOR NEW JUDGE

Wednesday, Aug. 30, 2017 (Halifax, NS) – Members of the media are invited to attend the robing ceremony for Justice Christa Brothers, one of two new judges appointed this summer to the Nova Scotia Supreme Court.

When: 3 p.m., Friday, Sept. 8, 2017

Where: Courtroom 301, The Law Courts, 1815 Upper Water St., Halifax

All attendees, including media, are asked to arrive by 2:45 p.m. As per the [Guidelines for Media & Public Access to the Courts](#), video cameras and still photography will be permitted inside the courtroom during the ceremony. Because space is somewhat restricted, camera operators may be limited to a pre-determined area of the courtroom to minimize any disruption.

Please note that Justice Brothers will not do any media interviews. Media are free to publish or broadcast any or all of Justice Brothers' remarks during the ceremony.

Justice Brothers graduated from the Schulich School of Law at Dalhousie University in 1996 and went on to serve as a clerk with the Nova Scotia Court of Appeal. She joined Stewart McKelvey in 1999 and became a partner in 2006. She received her Queen's Counsel designation in 2014 and was appointed to the Supreme Court on July 18, 2017.

Before her appointment, Justice Brothers was a dedicated member of the Nova Scotia Barristers' Society, including serving as the Chair of the Complaints and Investigation Committee, as an elected member of Council, and as the Second Vice-President. She mentored many while serving on the Board of Directors for the Legal Information Society of Nova Scotia and the National Insurance Law Subsection of the Canadian Bar Association. She has also served on the Board of Directors for the Canada Games Centre in Halifax.
