Amendments to Civil Procedure Rules of Nova Scotia

Rule 60A – Child and Adult Protection Miscellaneous Amendments

The Judges of the Supreme Court of Nova Scotia have approved amendments to the Civil Procedure Rules of Nova Scotia, including amendments to Rule 60A – Child and Adult Protection to deal with secure-treatment proceedings in the Supreme Court (Family Division).

Staff are in the process of incorporating these amendments into the official consolidated Rules. A notice will go out to the Bar when the updated official version is available online.
