Judge Bryna Hatt graduated with her law degree from the Schulich School of Law at Dalhousie University in 2007, and later went on to earn her Master of Laws (LL.M) from Osgoode Hall Law School.

Before her appointment, Judge Hatt was the founding partner of Fraser Hatt Law in Port Hawkesbury. At the time of her appointment, she was also a Certified Workplace Investigator and an Adjudicator of the Nova Scotia Small Claims Court. She has also taught Business Law at St. Francis Xavier University, in the Schwartz School of Business.

She was appointed a judge of the Provincial Court of Nova Scotia on Feb. 3, 2023, and now presides primarily in Pictou.
