Rule 59 – Supreme Court (Family Division) Rules Rule 60A – Child and Adult Protection Related Forms

The Judges of the Supreme Court of Nova Scotia have approved amendments to the Civil Procedure Rules of Nova Scotia, specifically Rule 59 – Supreme Court (Family Division) Rules, Rule 60A – Child and Adult Protection, and the related forms.

The changes were approved on June 11, 2024, and went into effect upon publication in the Royal Gazette on June 19, 2024.
