Amendments to the Civil Procedure Rules of Nova Scotia

Rule 90 - Civil Appeal

Thursday, Oct. 3, 2024

The Judges of the Nova Scotia Court of Appeal have approved amendments to the Civil Procedure Rules of Nova Scotia, specifically Rule 90 – Civil Appeal and related forms.

The changes were approved on Sept. 30, 2024, and went into effect upon publication in the Royal Gazette on Oct. 2, 2024. The full summary of the amendments and affected forms is available online at https://www.courts.ns.ca/operations/rules/civil-procedure-rule-amendments.

Please note that it will take some time to incorporate these amendments into the official consolidated Rules. A notice will go out to the Bar when the updated official version is available online.
