Nova Scotia Civil Procedure Rules Amendment May 26, 2022

The following Rules are amended as follows:

- 1. The phrase ", including the name of each witness," is added after the word "witnesses" in Rule 4.18(1).
- 2. The title to Rule 18.02 is changed to "Duties of party in an action and application in court".
- 3. The word "action" in Rule 18.02(1) is replaced with "proceeding".
- 4. The following Rule 24.02(3) is added to Rule 24.02:
 - (3) An appearance motion must be brought in the judicial district in which the action or application was initiated.
- 5. Rule 62 is repealed in its entirety.
